MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING OF CGEWCC, CHENNAI

The Executive Committee Meeting of the Central Government Employees Welfare Co-ordination Committee was convened on 07.12.2015 at 3.30 P.M. in the Conference Hall of the Office of the Chief Commissioner of Central Excise, 26/1, Mahatma Gandhi Road, Nungambakkam, Chennai-34 to seek approval for

- (1) the Annual Accounts of CGEWCC for the year 2014-15;
- (2) to finalise the list of Holidays for the year 2016 and
- (3) other matters.

The meeting was chaired by Smt. Janaki Arunkumar, I.R.S., Chief Commissioner of Central Excise, Chennai Zone, Chennai-34.

The Meeting commenced with the introduction of Chief Commissioner of Central Excise, Chennai Zone to the Members of the Executive Committee, who in turn, introduced themselves and the Department/Office they are representing. The Executive Members were welcomed and the significance and the need for effective functioning, active participation were detailed out and the co-operation of all the Members of the Committee was solicited so as to implement the welfare schemes of the Government of India.

APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR 2014-15

The Secretary tabled the Secretarial Accounts and Cultural Financial Accounts for the year 2014-15, highlighting the Income and Expenditure of CGEWCC. The Members approved and passed the same.

FINALIZATION OF HOLIDAY LIST FOR THE YEAR '2016':

After deliberations, the above 3 days to be observed as Closed Holidays for Tamil Nadu for the year 2016 were approved in addition to the 14 closed Holidays and also approved the list of Restricted Holidays for the year 2016.

It was also decided that **Deepavali** may be notified on 29.10.2016(Saturday) instead of 30.11.2016(Sunday) in conformity with the Holiday declared by the State Government vide G.O.No.Ms.1325 dated 30.11.2015.

Since **Naraka Chaturdhasi** falls on 29.10.2016(Saturday) which has already been declared as closed Holiday for **DEEPAVALI** by CGEWCC, the same has been removed from the list of Restricted Holidays.

Further, it was also decided that below mentioned Holidays to be observed by the Central Government Offices located in Tamil Nadu in terms of para 5.2 of DoPT letter dated 11.6.2015.
